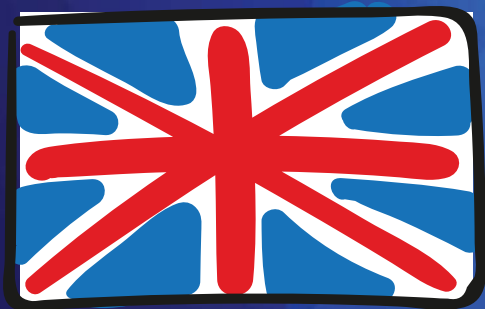

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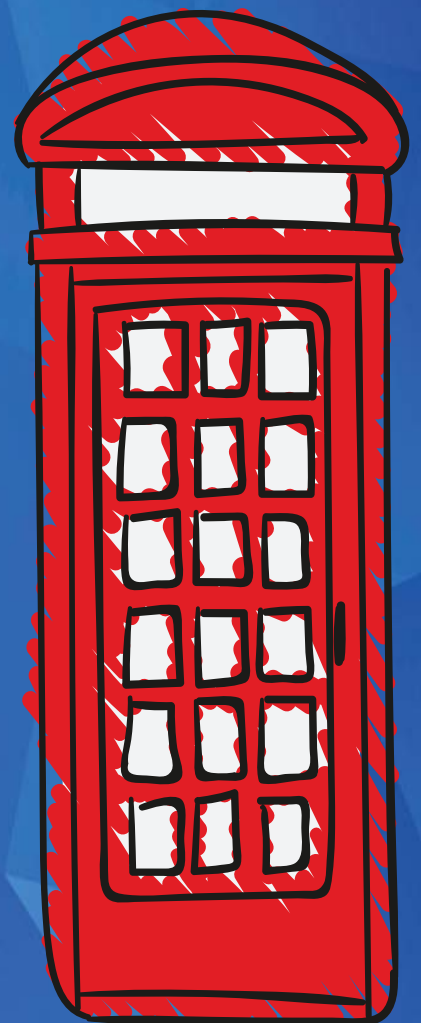

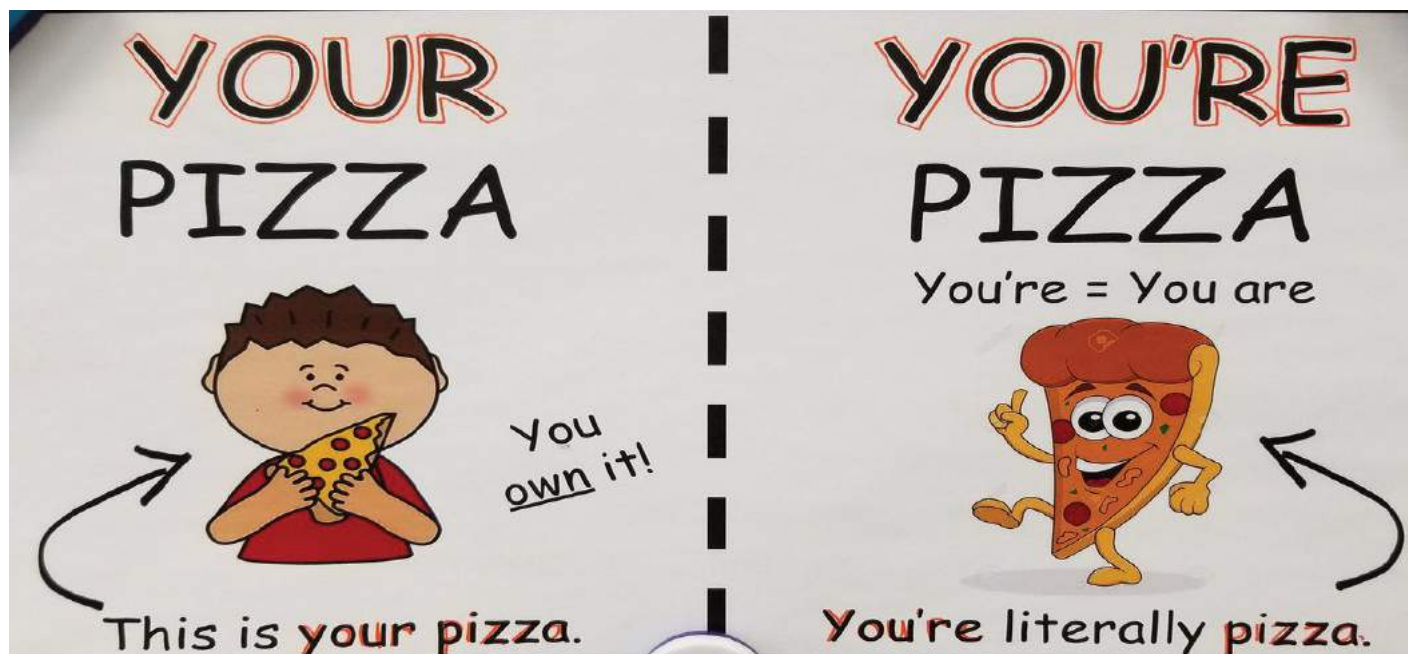




COMMON MISTAKES IN ENGLISH

YOUR VS YOU'RE ?

Have you ever wondered what's the difference between your and you're?
Well, you're about to find out!



Your

Your is the second person possessive adjective, used to describe something as belonging to you.

Your is always followed by a noun or gerund. Here are a few examples:

What is **your** name?

Is this **your** pen?

Your book is on the table.

This is **your** chair and this is mine.

What happened to **your** dog?

You're

You're is the contraction of "you are" and is often followed by the present participle (verb form ending in -ing). Here are some examples:

You're going to be late.

Is that what **you're** wearing?

I think **you're** lying.

You're welcome.

You're the best!

MOTHER'S DAY

Mother's Day Fun Fact

In Thailand, we celebrate Mother's Day on 12th August to commemorate the birthday of Her Majesty Queen Sirikit, the Mother of all Thai people.

Let's take a look at how and when other countries celebrate Mother's Day:

France

In 1950, France established the “fetes des meres” on the fourth Sunday in May.



China

China celebrates Mother's Day on the second Sunday of May, spending the day with gifts and festivities.

U.K.

From the 16th century, the U.K. observed on the fourth Sunday of Lent (in March) on a day called Mothering Sunday, when families came together to attend church.



Mexico

May 10, celebrated as Mother's Day, is the busiest day of the year for Mexican restaurants.

Then her mother said, "This school does exist" and she laughed...

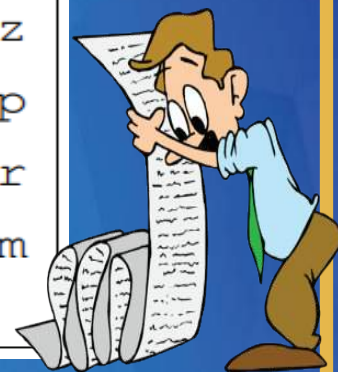
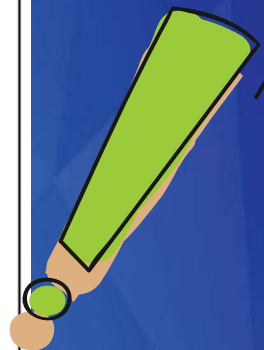
